This is an official notice of a Primary election to be conducted on 4/28/2020 in Susquehanna County. Uniformed Military and Overseas Voter Act (UMOVA) and Federal Write-in Absentee Ballot (FWAB) Susquehanna County, Pennsylvania Board of Elections

The Susquehanna County Board of Elections, pursuant to the provisions of P.L. 1333, known as "The Pennsylvania Election Code", hereby gives notice that nominations are to be made for the following public and party offices in Susquehanna County at the April 28, 2020 General Primary:

President of the United States (One)
Representative in Congress (12th District) (One)
Senator in the General Assembly (23rd District) (One)
Representative in the General Assembly 110th District and 111th District (One Each)
Attorney General (One)
Auditor General (One)
State Treasurer (One)

Party Office

Democratic National Delegates (Two Male, Two Female)
Delegates to the Republican National Convention (Three)
Alternate Delegates to the Republican National Convention (Three)

Who is covered under UMOVA?

Covered voters include all of the following:

- 1. A uniformed-service voter who is registered to vote in the Commonwealth, which includes a veteran who is bedridden or hospitalized due to illness or physical disability.
- 2. An overseas voter who is registered to vote in the Commonwealth.
- 3. A uniformed-service voter who is not registered to vote in the Commonwealth but who otherwise satisfies the voter eligibility requirement of this Commonwealth.
- 4. An overseas voter who is not registered to vote in the Commonwealth but who otherwise satisfies the voter eligibility requirements of this Commonwealth.

How do you apply for a military-overseas ballot?

- Covered voters who are registered to vote in the Commonwealth may apply for a militaryoverseas ballot using either an absentee ballot application or the Federal Post Card Application (FPCA).
- 2. Covered voters who are not registered to vote in the Commonwealth may use a FPCA to both register to vote and apply for a military-overseas ballot simultaneously.

3. A uniformed-service voter may use the FWAB to apply for a military-overseas ballot and vote at the same time.

Instructions

- You may request an absentee ballot from this office at any time prior to a Primary or Election. However, if time does not permit you to receive and return an official absentee ballot, you are also entitled to vote using the FWAB.
- You may use FWAB to vote for all candidates for all federal, state and local offices, and ballot initiatives.

- To vote, refer to page 3 of the FWAB.
- 1. To vote for U.S. President, Senator or Representative in Congress-write in the name of the candidate in the space provided on the FWAB.
- 2. To vote for state and local offices or for ballot initiatives-write the names of candidates or the ballot initiative in the Addendum Section of the FWAB.
- 3. Under the **Office/Ballot Initiative** heading, enter the office the candidate is running for or the title of the Ballot Initiative (referendum).
- 4. Under the **Candidate Name, Party Affiliation or Initiative Vote** heading, list the name of the candidate you wish to vote for, or if you are voting on a referendum questions write "yes" or "no".
