

ORDINANCE 2

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND REQUIRING THE LICENSING OF JUNK DEALERS IN THE BOROUGH OF LITTLE MEADOWS, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

The Borough of Little Meadows hereby ordains as follows:

(1) The word "Junk Dealer" as used in this Ordinance, shall mean any person who shall engage in the business of selling, buying and dealing in junk, including scrapped motor vehicles or any second hand material, the exact amount designating a "Junk Yard" to be decided by the Little Meadows Borough Council.

(2) All junk yards, salvage yards and other places used and maintained for the collection, storage and disposal of used or second-hand goods and materials shall at all times be maintained so as not to constitute a nuisance or a menace to the health of the community or of the residents nearby or a place for the breeding of rodents and venom.

(3) No person shall engage in business as a "Junk Dealer" in the Borough of Little Meadows without first having obtained a license from the Mayor for which license fee shall be \$75.00 for each and every calendar year, and such fee is to be for the use of the Borough. Such license shall be renewed annually on or before the first day of January. Such license shall state the name of the person to whom such license is issued and the premises from which such business is to be conducted. No person licensed under this ordinance shall, by virtue of one license, keep more than one place of business within the Borough of Little Meadows for the purpose of buying, selling and dealing in junk.

(4) Every dealer licensed under this ordinance shall keep and retain in original form for at least 48 hours any and all material received or purchased by him. Such premises shall not be open for business nor shall any work be done therein in connection with the storage, processing and transporting or removal of junk at any time on Sunday and shall at all times be subject to the inspection of the Police or any other official of the Borough of Little Meadows.

(5) No garbage or other organic waste, and no paper, rubbish, rags or other flammable articles or materials shall be stored on such premises.

(6) The "Junk Yard", salvage yard, or other place used and maintained for the collection, storage and disposal of used and second-hand goods and materials shall be confined to an area enclosed by a tightly built fence adequate to conceal such yard from the outside, and which shall be of a minimum height of six (6) feet.

(7) Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, before a Justice of the Peace in a summary proceeding, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than one hundred dollars (\$100) and costs of prosecution, PROVIDED: each day's violation of any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.
