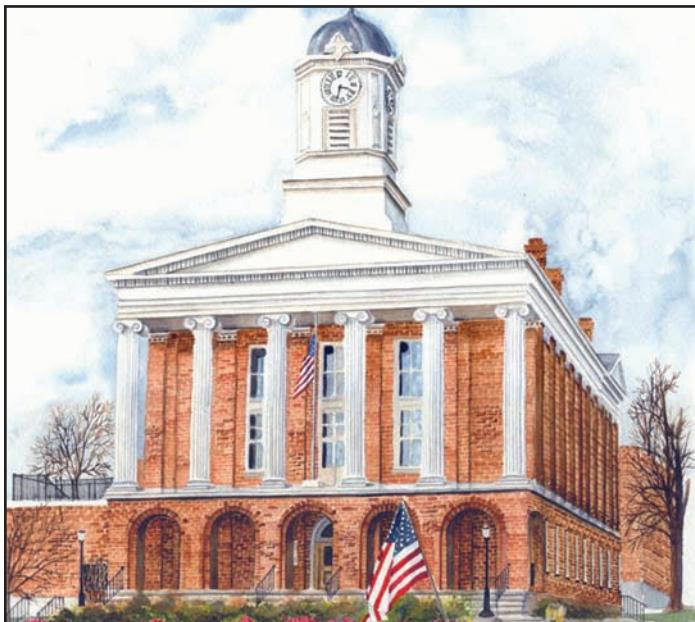

OPINION

I . Findings of Fact

1. Appellant Marv's Service Center (hereinafter referred to as Marv's) is a garage located in Great Bend, Susquehanna County, Pennsylvania. Marv's has a Department of Transportation Inspection Station Certificate of Appointment and is authorized to inspect passenger cars, light trucks, trailers 10,000 pounds or less, trucks 17,000 pounds or less, trailers over 10,000 pounds, and trucks over 17,000 pounds. (Pet. Ex. 1.)
2. Appellant Harry William Marvin, Jr., (hereinafter referred to as Marvin) was certified as an inspection mechanic by Appellee Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation (hereinafter referred to as PennDOT) and has been the inspection mechanic for Marv's since 1998. (Pet. Ex. 2.)
3. Marvin holds a Class "A" and "M" Pennsylvania Driver's License. (Pet. Ex. 2.) The holder of a Class A Driver's License, or commercial driver's license (CDL), is entitled to operate "any combination of vehicles with a gross vehicle weight rating of 26,001 pounds or more." 75 Pa.C.S. § 1504 (d)(1). A Class M holder can drive a motorcycle. 75 Pa.C.S. § 1504 (d)(4).

4. There are also license “endorsements” which allow a CDL operator to transport hazardous materials; drive a tank truck; drive passengers; operate a school bus; drive double or triple trailers; and drive a tank vehicle containing hazardous materials. 75 Pa.C.S. § 1610 (b)(2). Marvin does not have the endorsements authorizing him to operate a vehicle transporting hazardous materials or to drive a tank vehicle.
5. Marvin has been inspecting tank trucks for 10 years and has never received a citation for improperly inspecting tank trucks despite previous PennDOT audits. (Joint Stip. ¶ 12.) During a recent audit on September 2, 2017 of Marv’s inspection records, Marvin was questioned by a Quality Assurance Officer (hereinafter referred to as QAO) for PennDOT about an inspection performed on a propane tank truck owned by Hinds Oil, Inc. Marvin admitted to the QAO that he had performed an inspection on the propane tank truck even though he did not have an endorsement on his CDL to operate hazardous or tanker vehicles. (Com. Ex. 2.)¹
6. On December 15, 2017, PennDOT sent Marv’s an Order of Suspension of Official Inspection Station notifying Marv’s that its inspection certification was suspended for four months beginning January 19, 2018 as a result of inspection “by uncertified mechanic (inspecting vehicles without the proper endorsements on driver’s license).” (Com. Exs. 1 & 2.)
7. On December 28, 2017, Marv’s appealed the suspension of its Inspection Station certification contending that the suspension was improper because Marv’s did not violate any laws, rules, codes or PennDOT guidelines that would support a suspension.

II. Discussion

In automobile inspection certification suspension cases involving alleged violations of the Vehicle Code and regulations, PennDOT has the burden of proving the violations by a preponderance of the evidence. Fiore Auto Service v. Department of Transportation, Bureau of Motor Vehicles, 735 A.2d 734 (Pa. Comm. 1998). Marvin asserts that PennDOT cannot show any violation because no regulation exists that would require Marvin to have an endorsement on his license prior to inspecting a tank truck. PennDOT concedes that no such regulation exists. (Joint Stip. ¶ 16.) Conversely, PennDOT relies upon the Vehicle Code to support the suspension in that Marvin admitted to unlawfully operating the tank truck on a public roadway when he conducted the road test. (Joint Stip. ¶ 13.)

The Commonwealth has promulgated regulations concerning motor vehicle inspections. Initially, the regulations state that “[f]ailure to comply with the appropriate provisions of 75 Pa.C.S. (relating to Vehicle Code) will be considered sufficient cause

¹ As part of an inspection, the mechanic is required to perform a road test of the vehicle. See 67 Pa. Code §175.110. Marvin performed the road tests for the tank vehicles on a public roadway despite not having a valid endorsement on his CDL to operate the tank truck. (Joint Stip. ¶ 9.)

for suspension of inspection privileges.” 67 Pa. Code §175.51.² The regulations also provide that a mechanic desiring to maintain certification “[s]hall, as provided in subsection (a), have a valid driver’s license for each class of vehicle which the mechanic will inspect....” 67 Pa. Code §175.28(d)(2)(emphasis added). Furthermore, the regulations define a “certified inspection mechanic” as “[a] person who holds a valid certification card issued by the Bureau certifying that the person is qualified, has passed all requirements to inspect specific vehicles and holds a valid driver’s license for the correct class of vehicle.” 67 Pa. Code §175.2.

Marvin is the sole certified inspection mechanic for Marv’s. He holds a Class A driver’s license. As indicated, the regulations provide that to become certified or to maintain certification, Marvin must have a valid driver’s license for the class of vehicle he will inspect. Since the tank trucks fall within a class of vehicle for which Marvin holds a valid driver’s license, pursuant to the regulations, Marvin is certified to inspect the tank truck vehicles. Nevertheless, Marv’s has been charged with having an uncertified mechanic inspecting vehicles without the proper endorsements on Marvin’s driver’s license. This violation of the regulations is not supported as there is no requirement within the regulations that in order to maintain certification, the mechanic must have specific endorsements on his driver’s license for the type of vehicle he will inspect – only that the mechanic have a driver’s license for the class of vehicle he will inspect.

Section 1610(b)(1) & (2) of the Vehicle Code provides that in order to drive a tank vehicle and/or hazardous materials vehicle on public roads, the operator must possess an “X” endorsement on his or her driver’s license. See 75 Pa.C.S. § 1610(b)(1) & (2).³

Marvin admitted he does not have an endorsement on his CDL that would permit him to drive a tank truck yet he drove the tank trucks on a public roadway in the course of performing the inspections.⁴ By driving the tank trucks on a public highway without the required endorsements, Marvin was not in compliance with the Vehicle Code. Nevertheless, although the regulations provide that failure to comply with the provisions of the Vehicle Code will be considered sufficient cause for suspension of inspection

2 Language similar to this regulation is noted on the “Inspection Station Certificate of Appointment” issued to Marv’s by PennDOT, which states: “This certificate may be suspended or cancelled at any time if the provisions of the Vehicle Code or the inspection regulations are not being complied with” (Pet. Ex. 1.)

3 Section 1610(b)(1) provides that “[v]ehicles requiring an endorsement may not be driven unless the proper endorsement appears on the license.”

4 The inspection requires a “road test” as part of the inspection process. The Vehicle Code explains that “[a] certified official inspection mechanic performing a road test on a vehicle for the purpose of conducting a motor vehicle inspection is not required to hold a commercial driver’s license if the entire road test is performed on private property, provided the mechanic holds a valid Class C driver’s license and the road test area is of adequate space and size to perform a complete and proper road test as specified in department regulations.” 75 Pa.C.S. § 4726(a). Thus, if Marvin had road-tested the tank trucks as part of the inspection on a private road, there would be no issue of non-compliance. However, Marvin performed the road tests for the inspection of the tank trucks on a public roadway, not on private property.

privileges, PennDOT did not charge Marv's with failure to comply with the endorsement requirements of the Vehicle Code. Where PennDOT fails to charge the proper violation, no penalty can be imposed. Com., Dep't of Transp., Bureau of Motor Vehicles v. Wright Oldsmobile Honda, 569 A.2d 411, 413 (Pa. Commw. 1990).⁵

III. Conclusion

Based on the record, PennDOT has not met its burden of proving that Marvin was an uncertified mechanic when he inspected the Hinds Oil tank trucks. Thus, the suspension of Marv's Certificate of Appointment as an Official Inspection Station was not supported and will be dismissed.



⁵ PennDOT's suspension of Marv's certification was as a result of the inspection by an uncertified mechanic who was inspecting vehicles without the proper endorsements on his driver's license. As indicated, the regulations provide only that a certified mechanic must possess a valid driver's license for *each class of vehicle* which the mechanic will inspect. Marvin does hold a Class A driver's license and therefore, under the regulations, he was not an uncertified mechanic and a suspension based on a determination that Marvin was uncertified at the time of the inspections is not supported. Indeed, PennDOT conceded that Marvin was a certified mechanic and could have lawfully inspected the tank truck if he had simply conducted a road test on private property. In other words, PennDOT does not contend that Marvin could not inspect the tank truck; instead, PennDOT is seeking to suspend Marv's certification for Marvin's violation of the Vehicle Code. PennDOT did not charge such a Vehicle Code violation in its December 15, 2017 order of suspension.
