Second by Member SarahRae Luce. Ayes: Unanimous. Motion Carried.

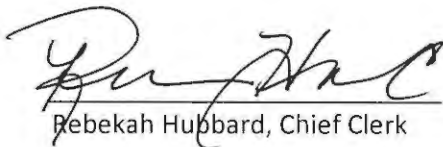

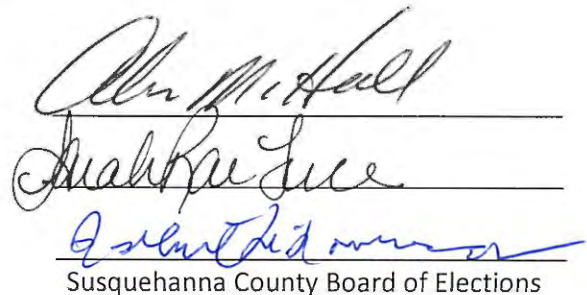
